

Foreclosure Prevention Intake Coordinator

Position Overview

The Affordable Housing Corporation of Lake County is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization dedicated to increasing and preserving affordable housing opportunities for low- and moderate- income households and strengthening communities throughout Lake County. Established in 1992, AHC helps individuals and families rent homes, buy homes, repair homes, and save homes from foreclosure. The primary responsibility of the Foreclosure Prevention Intake Coordinator is to support AHC's foreclosure prevention counselors with general administrative support and to gather and manage detailed documentation that is required from potential clients who are seeking assistance from AHC's foreclosure prevention program.

- Strong interpersonal skills, including the ability to work with clients who are in stressful situations to ensure they accurately and completely submit all required documentation

- Background in loan processing or mortgages a plus
- Bilingual (Spanish) a plus

Duties

- Collect and review client documentation and follow up with clients to ensure a complete foreclosure prevention intake packet is prepared for AHC's foreclosure counselors
- Assist callers and walk-in's with information about AHC's programs
- Enter client data in various electronic client management systems
- Maintain client files
- Assist with program reporting
- General administrative tasks
